James. With nine original compositions and two covers, this album delivers to the listener the most significant moments in Vittorio's lifetime through sincere portraits of his experiences. Pitzalis's life is as jagged as the coastline of his island, Sardinia; tangled, painful, and as full of crossroads as the swampy streets of the blues, the only ones that Vittorio is truly capable of living.

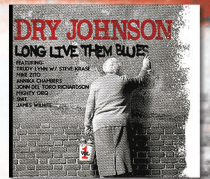
