Jerome Fulton is a Memphis native and Memphis College of Art alumnus who has been commanding the art world with his masterpieces for over forty years. Fulton's artistic expressions and creative mediums have been honed through his extensive world travels, and are brought to life in his elaborate use of watercolor, tin, and naturally aged wood. In Fulton's art, viewers will find an infusion of Deep South culture, blues music, and ancient world culture (Egyptian and Nubian) – all blended with broader strains of American history. His work has been featured in the Museum of Science and Industry, Chicago, the Walter Payton Foundation, the DuSable Museum of African American History in Chicago, the Cultural Center of Helena, Arkansas, and the Clarksdale Cultural Center in Clarksdale, Mississippi.
